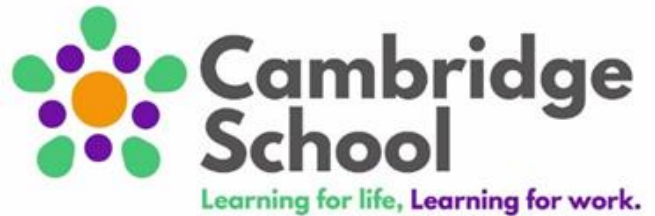


# Newsletter
