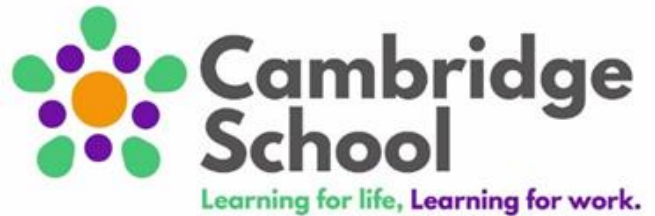

Dear Parent/Carer,

I want to reassure you that we are doing everything we can to keep your child safe in school and we are following all the government guidelines around containment of the coronavirus. We are providing sanitising alcohol based hand gel in every class and at the entrance to the school in reception. We are asking all visitors to use this on entry and exit. We are also asking every visitor to disclose whether they have travelled to, or been in contact with anyone who has travelled to, any of the high risk countries, particularly Italy, Iran, or China. All of the children are being educated on how to effectively wash their hands and be as thorough as possible. They have designed some eye catching and attention grabbing posters. We are being vigilant regarding any child showing cold or flu like symptoms. If your child feels ill please call 111 to get medical advice. We do not want to promote panic, fear, or hysteria and we are educating the children to look after their hygiene, their health, and not to be too anxious. We will keep you informed as soon as the policy of containment moves on to the delay stage and if this has an impact on school routines.

Today it is International Women's Day and I want to celebrate the strong mothers, daughters, and sisters that we have in this school. It is our mission to promote equality and diversity so today we salute the successes and achievements of all the girls and women who make Cambridge School great.
