Dear Parent/Carer,

We have reached the end of another half term and unfortunately, despite the lockdown restrictions being lifted, the pandemic is still rearing its ugly head. We had to send one small bubble home this week due to four children developing Covid symptoms, particularly a dry persistent cough. This meant that all the pupils who shared their transport into school also had to go home as they were counted as close contacts. Fortunately, all the PCR tests came back as negative but this could have been avoided if parents had not sent their child in to school with a cough. At this time, when variants are still circulating, it is vital that you exercise extreme caution and keep your child at home and get a PCR test if they are displaying any cold or flu or Covid-like symptoms.

On a more positive note, we hosted a Youth Futures and Metropolitan Police event this week where a group of Green Pod students met police officers to share their thoughts and experiences about how the police interact and engage with young people in the community. The event really transformed the attitudes of both police officers and our students and respect and trust was created as everybody listened to each other and developed a shared understanding. The police and Youth Futures staff praised our students for their honesty, maturity and confidence and the staff for the care and nurture they show for the students in their care. Thanks to Lucy Allen for organising this event and praise to all the Green Pod staff and students who participated. We hope to host similar events in the future enabling more students to have their voices heard.
