We have received written feedback from our Hammersmith and Fulham Principal Advisor regarding "the state of the Cambridge nation." It is overwhelmingly positive and I want to share the headlines with you. Keith Tysoe praised the positive and purposeful learning environment throughout the school and was impressed by the clear progress the students are making. There was a good amount of work in students' books and high levels of pupil engagement in learning. Learners were working both independently and collaboratively and were able to talk confidently about what they were learning. A good staff and pupil rapport was witnessed across the school. We do have things that we need to improve and two of our main targets are to increase the opportunities for students to write sustained texts to develop their writing stamina and resilience and to teach Maths subject specific vocabulary to enable students to solve problems. We are holding a Parents' Evening on 1st December where parents and carers will be able to examine all the work that their children have produced!

We are closed to pupils on Friday 19th November for a staff INSET day which means that students will be at home on Children in Need day. To make up for this, students are engaging in fun activities today, organised by the BTec Childcare class including art workshops, biscuit decorating and cupcake making. Well done to the BTec Childcare group, ably led by Sue Chadwick.
