Our resilience is being well and truly tested here at Cambridge. Yesterday, we had 4 positive Covid test results in the student population and one staff member also tested positive. This is vindication of our decision to keep testing the entire school population twice a week as it helps us to manage the infection rate and identify children and adults who need to isolate. I need you all to help us by following our guidelines on testing at home and informing us of the results and to keep your child at home if they develop any Covid symptoms to prevent spreading the virus unnecessarily.

Hannah Goldman-Brown wrote to you yesterday via ParentMail regarding donations for refugees and victims of war in Ukraine. We are collecting items in school and this is a good way for students to learn about the consequences of war and also teaches them how to be responsible citizens. Many of our students are concerned about the war and are troubled by what they are seeing on television. School staff are treating the topic sensitively and reassuring them that they are safe, but are answering their questions. School is vibrant once again with trips in and out really helping the students access new opportunities and possibilities. This week, many classes learned about International Women's Day and they learned about many inspirational women in society. We are proud of our personal development curriculum and its emphasis on diversity and equality.
