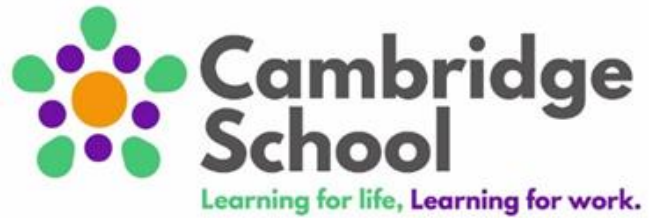


# Newsletter
