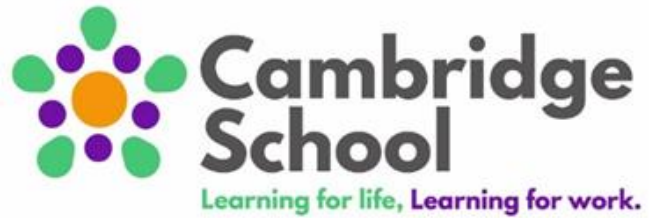


# Newsletter

Dear Parent/Carer,

It has been a positive and upbeat week at school in keeping with the sunny summer vibes. School was festooned in colour yesterday as many pupils and staff dressed in rainbow colours to celebrate LGBTQ+ Day. We have been reaching out to other schools in the spirit of partnership and collaboration. Ms Dawkins took a group of 4 eager girl readers; Aya Benlazreg-Bellil, Candiie-Mai Easton, Kyah Henry and Summer Shand to Ark Swift Primary school to be reading mentors to younger children. The girls were excellent ambassadors for the school and took their responsibilities as reading buddies very seriously. They came over to my office to tell me how exciting it had been and how they were desperate to continue the programme. Shakespeare class teamed up with a class from Queensmill School yesterday to have a picnic in the park and play a range of games. This helped them with their social skills as they had to communicate with children with more significant ASD needs than themselves. Mr Pritchard and the team reported that it was a major success.

I can report that the school is buzzing with learning activity. I walked round all classes with Peter Haylock, the new Director of Education for Hammersmith and Fulham, and he was most impressed with the quality of learning around the school and the respectful way students were conducting themselves. I am going to single out Akala class for praise as they were rehearsing for their Assembly presentation and doing some inspirational work quoting Martin Luther King and Maya Angelou. We also hosted 23 students of our new intake for September this week and they had the opportunity to engage in learning and social activities with their teachers and each other. Parents and students gave overwhelmingly positive feedback and the future is looking bright and rosy.
