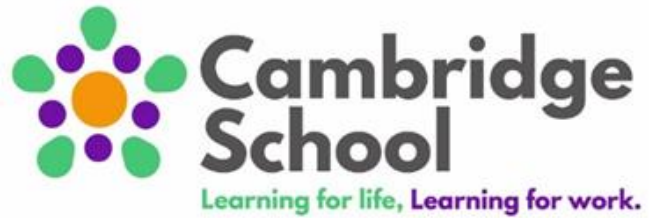

Dear Parent/Carer,

The school is proud of its students' achievements in the public exams which were sat in the summer term of 2021-2022. Students in Years 9, 10 and 11 were entered for exams and we had more entries than ever before as we prepare our learners for college and life beyond in the real world of work. It is our school vision that we are preparing our young people to live as independent a life as possible and to gain qualifications which put them on a pathway to success. 100% of learners who sat Entry Level 2 and Entry Level 3 English passed and 83% passed Functional Skills level 1. In Maths, 88% of learners entered for Entry Level 1 and Entry Level 2 passed with 100% passing Entry Level 3. However, learners who were able to access the more difficult Functional Skills level 1 in Maths, struggled and 45% passed.

Results in BTEC were very pleasing with 93% of learners gaining a Certificate. Results were excellent across the different subject areas including Art and Design, Hospitality, Childcare, Sport and Performing Arts. We will be inviting our ex-Year 11s in later in the term to celebrate their successes and formally present them with their certificates. Some have already come back in to school to share their positive stories about their transition to college. We will be inviting them in to talk to our current Year 11s about how to succeed in their exams and act as positive role models.

We are busy baselining our students so that we know their starting points to set meaningful goals and targets. Students are responding well to these challenges and the learning culture is strong. If parents have any questions about their child's learning, please contact their class teacher in the first instance.
