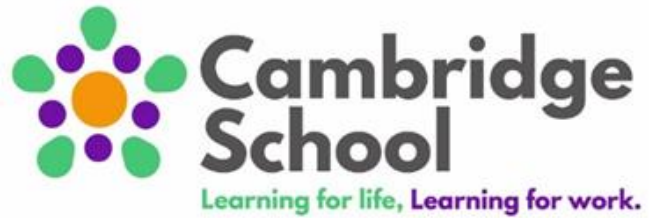

Last week students from Angelou and Einstein classes ventured out to the British Museum to explore the history and culture of Ancient Greece. They enjoyed a stimulating sensory story and took part in a traditional Olympic long jump and were all presented with a crown of olive branches like true champions! The students had a fascinating and amazing experience visiting one of the most prestigious museums in the country. Their behaviour was impeccable and every opportunity to practise life skills was taken including safety in the community, using public transport and interacting positively with new people and environments. Exposing our students to unfamiliar situations helps them to learn and grow as individuals. The students enjoyed a delicious packed lunch made by our catering queen, Becky Dent and had to choose different items from a menu. The class staff were really appreciative of the support they received from the TfL staff at White City station who escorted the Cambridge Party to their own carriage, making them feel like royalty!

Yesterday we hosted a visit by two educational psychologists who were working with the class teams in Green Pod to evaluate the impact of our provision. It was an illuminating experience for all and the feedback was really positive which is testament to the dedication of staff and the hard work being put in by the students to meet their goals. We are particularly proud of how our Year 7s in Akala and Rashford classes have made the difficult emotional and social transition to secondary school. This can be traumatic for vulnerable learners, but they are taking it in their stride.
