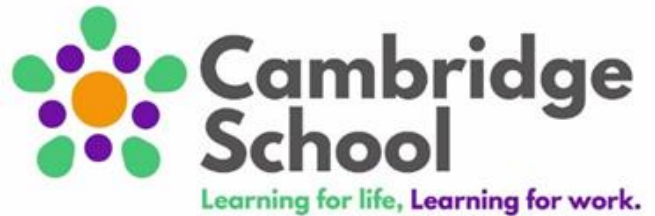


# Newsletter
