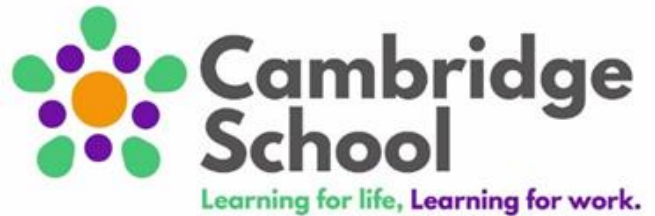

Dear Parent/Carer,

It looks like we are heading in to another cold snap next week after the untypically mild weather since we returned to school in 2023. I want to clarify the rules on school uniform as some of you have been confused by recent communications regarding the wearing of hoodies in particular. We understand that many of you have spent money on hoodies for your children in good faith and that family finances are tight. Hoodies can be worn to school but can NOT be worn inside the building. They can be worn outside in the playground this academic year. We will be introducing a clear uniform policy for September and I want parents and the School Council closely involved as part of the consultation process.

It was unfortunate that we had to cancel the Winter Fayre at such short notice before we broke up for Christmas, but we are keen to reach out to more parents to get involved in school life. There are two ways that you can get involved as a parent. Firstly, you can join the Parents' Association. We will be writing to you soon with details about the next meeting. Secondly, if you want to represent parents on the governing body, you can stand for election. We currently have a vacancy for a parent governor and will be holding elections later this term. It is a chance to support the school and ensure the views and voices of parents are heard loud and clear. Communications will be winging their way to you before half term.
