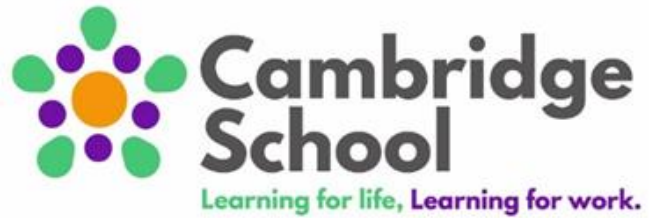


# Newsletter

Dear Parent/Carer,

It is hard to believe that we are into the Summer term already! This school year is passing incredibly quickly and this term is packed full of excitement and educational opportunities.
